Meeting at Hollywood bowl in the Intu Derby at 4pm - finishing at St Mary's Church, Derby, for 6.30pm Mass. The cost is £7 per person.

The young people will need to be dropped off at the Intu in Derby at 4pm where we will go bowling and then onto Nando's or somewhere in the food court of the Intu for food together. At 6pm we will then walk across to St Mary's Church to join the parish for the 6.30pm evening Mass. Young people will need to be collected at 7.30pm from St Mary's Church. To make the event as accessible as possible we have chosen a central location and tried to keep the price down. The £7 will be for the bowling on the evening and the DCCYW budget will cover the cost of food for those who attend.

'Faith in Families' Christmas Appeal

Donations of food can include Christmas puddings, mince pies, tea & coffee, biscuits, chocolates/selection boxes, tinned foods, jam, crisps etc. Other items needed include new gifts (books, games, stationery etc.) for children aged 2 to 11, warm baby and children's clothing (including hats, scarves, gloves, socks), toiletries, gift vouchers and other items suitable for older children.
