Holy Week

In this week we unite our lives with the life of Jesus Christ. We share so much pain and suffering but, in our life and loving, we share also in his new life. This is not something we understand by reading a book. We can only understand love by loving. By sharing in God's love we share, also, in his resurrection. Holy Week takes us through and unites us with the life and suffering and resurrection of Jesus.

The times of Holy Week Services are as follows:

Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday: Mass at 9.00am

At **11.30am on Wednesday** there is the Chrism Mass

in Nottingham Cathedral celebrated by Bishop Patrick and the priests of the Diocese.

Wednesday evening there is the **Stations of the Cross at 7.00pm** led by the young people of St Joseph's (see below).

Maundy Thursday. Mass of the Last Supper at 7.00pm, followed by **exposition of the Blessed Sacrament to 10.00pm.**

Good Friday At **3.00pm** the **Commemoration of the Lord's Passion.** At **7.00pm Stations of the Cross.**

Holy Saturday: At **8.00pm Easter Vigil and Mass**

Easter Sunday: Mass at 8.45am and 10.15am

On Good Friday morning the local Christian Churches unite at the Methodist Church at Dean Street at 10.00am to reflect on how Jesus gave himself and continues to give himself to us. This is an important gathering of Christians in this part of Derby - do come if you can.

Stations of the Cross, with reflections by St Joseph's Youth Club, organised by the Knights of St Columba, on **Wednesday, 17th April at 7.00pm.** Refreshments (chip-butties) will be available afterwards in the Church Hall. This is an annual event and always special as the younger people lead us in prayer.
